Authors must submit an abstract (not more than 3 pages including figures) by email to symposia@sulphurinstitute.org, no later than Friday, November 27, 2009. Abstracts submitted will be evaluated for relevance to sulphur and related industries, originality and timeliness. Authors will be notified of acceptance no later than Friday, December 18, 2009. Final electronic manuscripts of accepted papers must be received by TSI no later than Friday, February 26, 2010, to be included in the proceedings. Authors must agree that published proceedings are TSI property which will be provided to symposium participants and made available for purchase following the symposium. One author for each accepted paper will be granted a complimentary registration for the symposium. Please use Microsoft Word format for your paper.
