## **Sulphuric Acid Logistics**

The majority of sulphuric acid consumed in the North American market is produced through sulphur burning for internal use by phosphate fertilizer and metals producers. However, there is a large portion of sulphuric acid produced through base metals smelting, spent acid generation from refineries as well sulphur-based production for the merchant market that is traded in the domestic market. Sulphuric acid is also imported from offshore sources such as Europe and from Mexico by rail. This presentation will look at the supply system for sulphuric acid including import points and domestic logistics such as barge, rail and truck transport.

The importance of sulphuric acid to the sulphur market will also be reviewed including an overview of sulphur consumption for acid production at key facilities. Sulphur consumption at these sites is critical in keeping sulphur moving to market as to not constrict oil refining and gas processing operations.
