Phosphate Fertilizer Outlook

Several factors including continued strong end-user demand, lean pipeline inventories, several planned or unplanned production outages, a run-up in sulphur costs, and significant logistical disruptions have combined to cause the sharp spike in phosphate prices during the first quarter of 2014. The near term outlook will hinge on the level of agricultural commodity prices, India's import appetite, Chinese export economics and incremental supplies from recently commissioned capacity. Long term supply and demand fundamentals continue to look relatively balanced and stable.
