Concurrent with the symposium, TSI will hold its 2010 Annual Meeting of the Members and Directors. TSI's achievements and benefits will be reported to the membership and the organization's future direction will be discussed. ABOUT THE VENUE

With 153.2 billion barrels of oil reserves and 910.5 trillion cubic feet of gas reserves – second only to Russia – Qatar has an important role in the global oil and gas industries. Within Qatar, this is highlighted by the development of the massive Ras Laffan industrial complex, a facility that is critical to handling Qatar's sulphur supply.

Ras Laffan Industrial City covers 106 square kilometers and is expected to expand to 250 square kilometers. The city's goal is to become a multi-purpose industrial complex utilizing gas and liquids derived from staging of the North Field Gas Development Program. It now operates an industrial port and provides integrated industrial service facilities, including security, fire safety, a medical center, environmental regulations and a support services area.

An exclusive for symposium registrants – With the assistance of a TSI member in the region, TSI has arranged for symposium delegates to tour this exceptional complex, not frequently open to general visitors. Only fully-registered symposium delegates and speakers may participate in this tour. TSI must meet a specific deadline to submit delegate information to Ras Laffan due to security requirements. THE DEADLINE FOR SYMPOSIUM AND RAS LAFFAN TOUR REGISTRATION IS MARCH 17, 2010. TSI will submit your Ras Laffan tour registration form information (Form #2) directly to the Ras Laffan facility on your behalf.


