TSI publishes Sulphur – a dynamic nutrient in Chinese agriculture brochure

WASHINGTON, DC, July 9, 2015 – The Sulphur Institute (TSI) announced the publication of its newest brochure: Sulphur – a dynamic nutrient in Chinese agriculture. This brochure delves into the various types of fertilizers available to correct deficiencies and examines aspects of application management. The publication concludes a program that involved a multi-year partnership with China's National Agricultural Technology Extension and Service Center from the Ministry of Agriculture. The Sulphur Institute has identified China's potential to be 1.8 million tons of sulphur consumption annually as a fertilizer nutrient.
