Hydrogen Sulphide: Regulations and Workplace Safety

Charles Simpson CSP, VP of York Energy Services, is a recognized expert on hydrogen sulphide safety and serves as the Vice Chairman of the ANSI Z-390 "Accepted Practices for Hydrogen Sulfide Safety Training Programs" committee. He will provide an update on recent regulatory developments and changes to consensus standards with a particular focus on the impact of the recent lowering of the safe exposure limit for hydrogen sulphide by the American Conference of Governmental Industrial Hygienists. Potential impacts of the changes on the sulphur industry will be discussed. Mr. Simpson will also present information on some of the lesser known health effects of exposure to hydrogen sulphide.
