

TSI actively participates in a Hydrogen Sulfide Coalition (H₂S Coalition) affording TSI with an additional source of continued regulatory monitoring and a voice in addressing any proposals for new regulations or requirements. Recent actions by environmental groups and influential standards organizations have necessitated H₂S Coalition responses.

Assessment

- Sierra Club submitted a letter to US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), recommending that H₂S be listed as a HAP. ACGIH recommended lower H₂S Threshold Limit Value.

Development

- TSI co-authored comments submitted to the EPA opposing action on Sierra Club's recommendations. Letters were also sent to ACGIH providing factual and practical information on H₂S and the limits of monitoring ppm.

Distribution

- Technical information developed on issues were distributed to members. TSI continues to monitor for actions that could lead to listing H₂S as a HAP or lowering limits to unachievable levels.

Value to Member

- TSI presents accurate factual and practical H₂S information to discourage unjustified and burdensome regulations.
- Communications to EPA in response to Sierra Club's request provide industry's perspective and accurate information on H₂S properties.
- TSI provides members reports on regulatory activity.
