Improvements in Molten Sulphur Cargo Tank Transportation Neil McInnis — Vice President Schiber Truck Company, Inc.

This presentation will inform delegates about recent activities and related safety and handling improvements for overthe-road cargo tank transportation of molten sulphur within North America. These advancements in the industry were aided through The Sulphur Institute's (TSI) Road Transportation Task Group (RTTG), which was formed to discuss and share safe practices while brainstorming alternatives for improving the handling of sulphur.

Within its past meetings, TSI's RTTG aimed to discover both short and long-term situations regarding road transportation, especially with loading and unloading of molten sulphur, and discuss other issues facing the industry such as driver safety, H₂S exposures, fall protection, and prevention of burns and spills. Throughout this presentation, improvements and solutions designed to address these issues and improve safety of sulphur transport in cargo tank trucks will be summarized and explained for the audience.
