Bulk Freight

As freight becomes a larger part of the delivered cost of sulphur, this segment will give an insight of the fundamentals of the global dry bulk freight market as well as challenges for ship owners in the future. The presentation will review global dry cargo market fundamentals and provide an overview of global ocean transportation vessel supply and demand. This will include the effect on new orders and role sulphur plays in this market.

The presentation will also consider the effect of ship owners securing higher efficiency ships for lower shipping costs. Updates on new regulations that could adversely affect the cost and conditions of carrying bulk sulphur will be discussed. It will also seek to answer the question "What challenges lie ahead for ship owners and sulphur shippers?"
